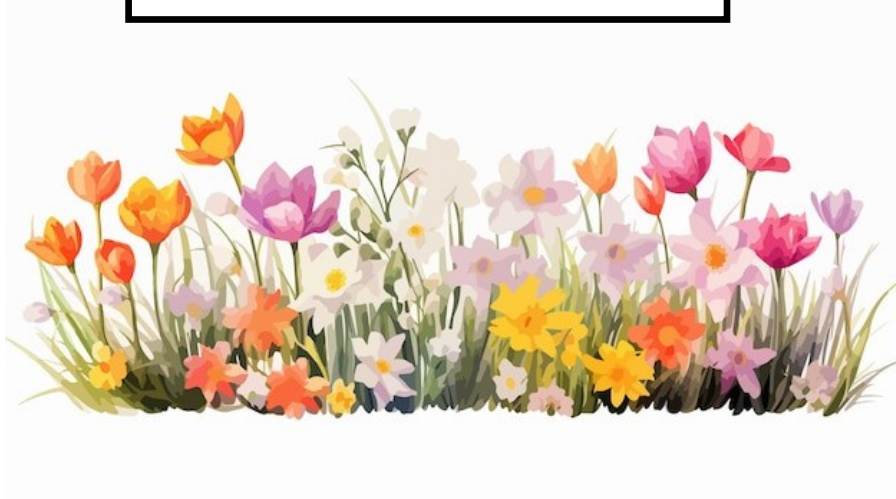


Penn Coachmen Old Mill Stream Rally 2026
