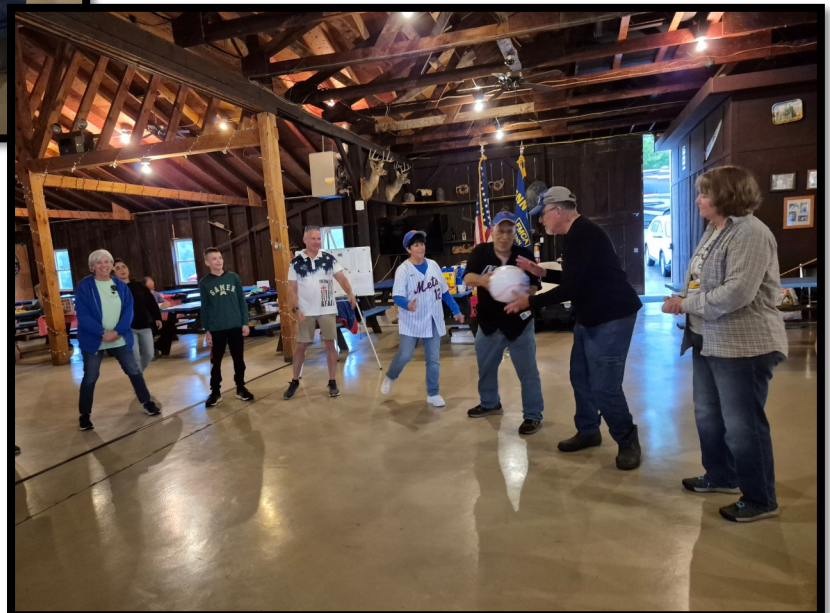

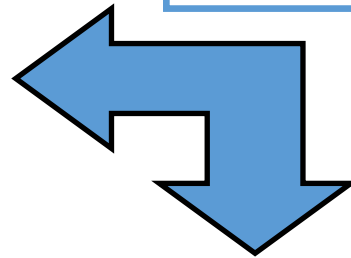

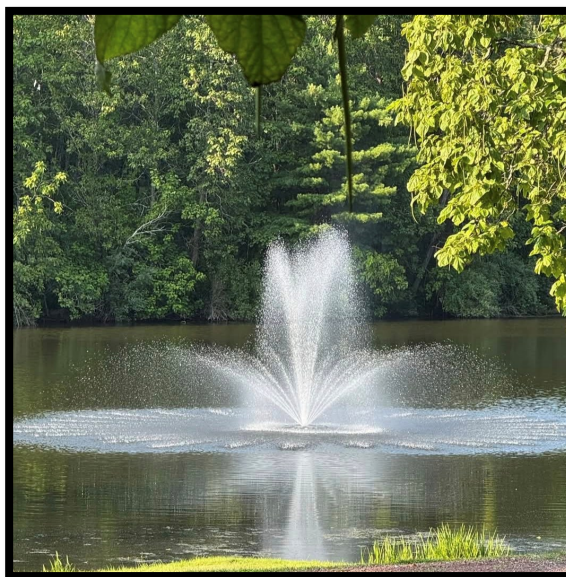


Lakewood Campground
