National Directors Report

The FMCA Governing Board meeting was held July 7, 2021. In attendance were delegates representing 71% of the voting members present satisfying a quorum for the meeting. The following is a summary of the major agenda items that were addressed and their outcomes:

- Election of National Officers: Rett Porter, National President, Gary Milner, National Senior Vice President, Kathie Balogh, National Secretary and Barbara Smith, National Treasurer.
- Future national conventions voted and approved were:
 - Winter 2022 convention in Tucson, AZ March 23-26-under contract.
 - Summer 2022 convention in Lincoln, Nebraska August 24-27-under contract
 - Winter 2023 convention in Perry, Georgia March 15-18-under contract
- Approval of the 2021 budget based on dues of \$60 for new member and \$50 for renewal.
 - FMCA has had an increase in membership since the dues roll back and this trend is anticipated with the due's reduction
 - FMCA is in good fiscal shape, best it's been in years
- Membership Fees and Dues P&P #1017
 - New Member \$60
 - Renewing Member \$50
 - No longer available are Full Lifetime Member and Life Member
 - Annual Dues of FMCA Commercial Members shall be the same as Full Family Memberships or \$50
- Chapter and Associate Chapter Application P&P 3009
 - It was voted to eliminate the \$35 formation fee
- Strategic Planning to be a priority: average age of a FMCA member is 71 with two- thirds 65 or older.
