Apple Pound Cake-modified recipe from Southern Plate

Cake

- 3 Cups all-purpose flour
- 2 Cups sugar
- 1 Cup vegetable oil
- ½ Cup orange juice
- 4 eggs
- 3 teaspoons baking powder

Filling

- 5 medium size apples, peeled and chopped (about 4 Cups)
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- ½ Cup or a little less of sugar

Directions

Generously grease and flour a bunt pan. Preheat oven to 350

Combine cake ingredients in large mixing bowl. Electric mixer until thoroughly mixed and smooth

Pour about ½ of the batter into the prepared bunt pan and put about ½ of the apple mixture over the batter.

Pour remaining batter over the apples and then add remaining apple mixture on top.

Bake 350 for 1 hour to 1 hour 10 minutes until tooth pick (or wooden shish kabob skewer) is

Cool 10 minutes before turning out onto plate.

Cool completely and dust with powdered sugar
